

Aussie Cambodians Get Together to Build 4 big 20000 Litre Water Tanks in Takeo



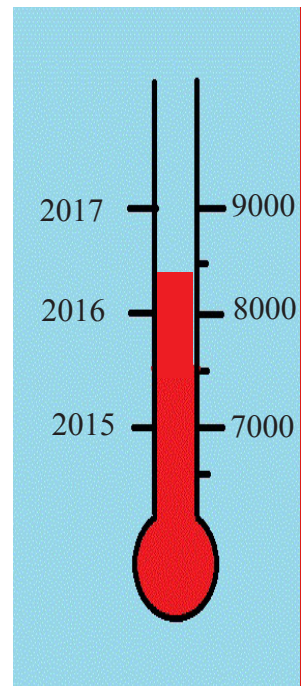

Aussie Cambodians collectively donated \$8,000 to build 4 big 20,000 Ltr water tanks in 4 schools in Takeo Province. One of these big tanks equal 9 regular tanks. We now have 2379 tanks in Takeo.

With these new tanks our tank numbers will go up to 8445 providing water for 355,428 kids in 3 provinces.



We have built 8445 tanks by the end of July 2017.

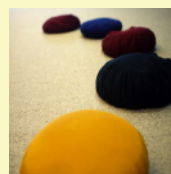
