

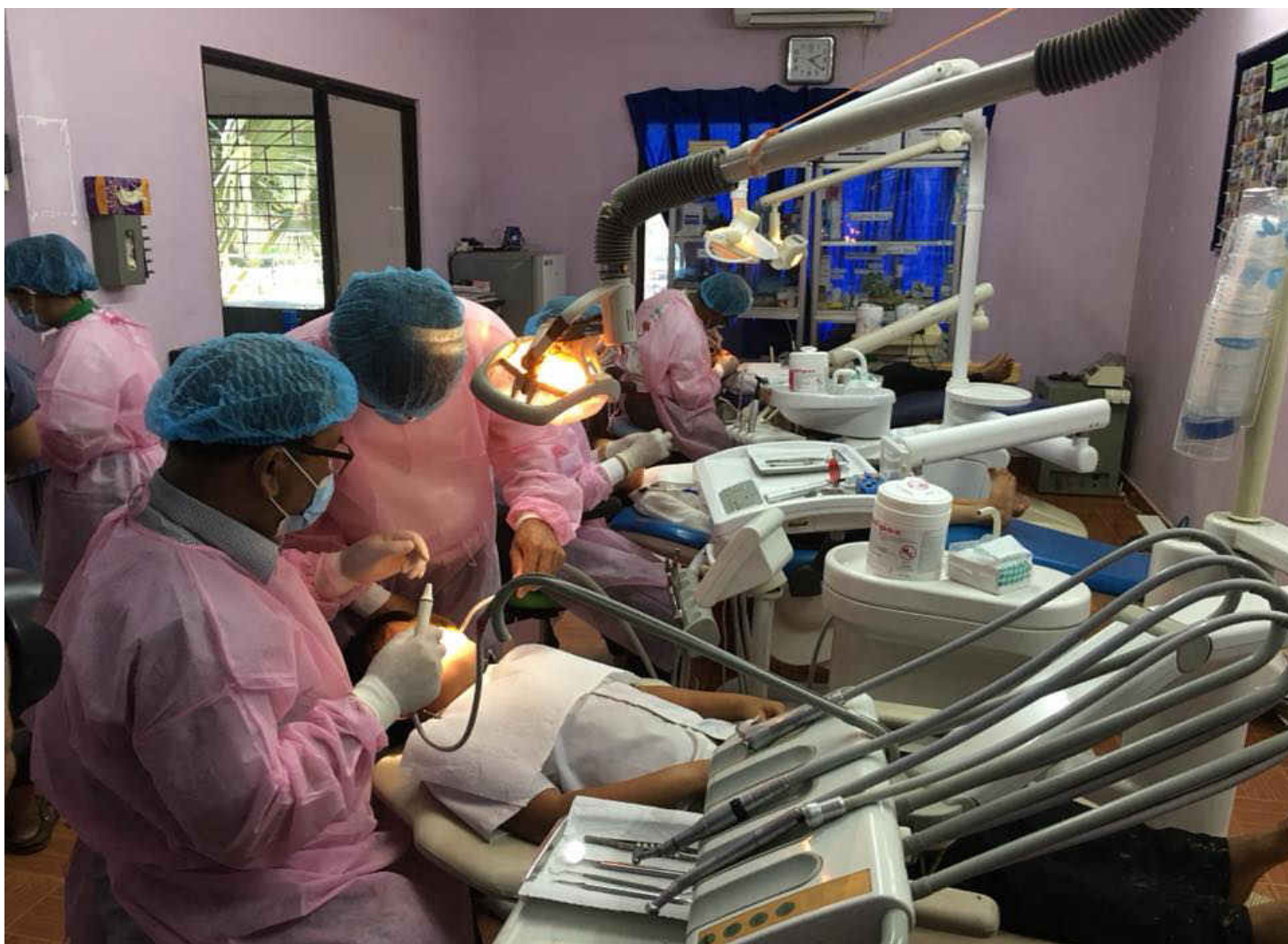

I- Project Achievements 2017

1- Dental Clinics

- ❖ Provided free dental treatments to **14,898** children including *Prevention: 9,180 cases, Restoration: 15,903 cases, Extraction: 3,305 cases and Root Canal Treatment: 268 cases.*
- ❖ Provided Oral Health Education (OHE) to **15,363** children at remote schools in Kampot, Kampong Speu and Takeo.
- ❖ Delivered **4,976** toothbrushes and **60** big and **132** small tubes of tooth paste.

1-1- Cecilia Dental Clinic at Kbal Romeas, Kampot

This clinic is located at Kbal Romeas Primary School about 7 kilometers from Kampot. The clinic is staffed with two dentists, three dental assistants, a driver, a night guard and a cleaner. On average the clinic provides free dental treatments to between 500 and 600 children from various schools in the area every month. Below are the statistics of dental treatments provided by the clinic in 2017.

1-2- Kim Yon Dental Clinic in Kampong Speu

This clinic was started in 2011 and is located at Phnom Sruoch High School in Kampong Speu province. The clinic has four staff a dentist, two assistants and a night guard. The clinic provides free dental treatments to around 500 children a month from various schools in the target areas.

Below are the statistics of dental treatments provided by the clinic in 2017.

1-3 Mobile Dental Clinic

Once a month for five days, our mobile clinic goes to a school in the remote area of Kampot, Takeo and Kampong Speu and is set up to provide dental treatments to the children at place. In 2017, the mobile clinic went to 12 schools and provided dental treatments to **1744** children at 10 different schools in Kampot, Takeo and Kampong Speu.

Below are the statistics of dental treatments provided by the clinic in 2017.

1-4 Oral Health Education (OHE)

OHE is another activity which conducted regularly to provide awareness of dentistry to children. OHE is conducted at both clinics (CDC & KYC) by our dental assistants and at remote schools by our dental assistant and CLA.

In 2017, **15,363** children from various schools received OHE from our dental assistants. The message given by OHE includes how to brush teeth regularly and properly two times a day; avoid consuming food and drink that cause tooth decay.



1-5 World Oral Health Day Celebration

In March, 2017 collaborated with Cambodian Dental Association (CDA) of Cambodia and supported by Signal Company, our clinic celebrated the World Oral Health Day at some schools in Kampot and Kampong Speu. During the event, we delivered **4072** toothbrushes and **3,614** big tubes of toothpaste and thousands of dental leaflets donated by Signal Company to around **4,000** children.



1-6 10th Year Anniversary of the Clinic

On the 28th of December, 2017 we celebrated the **10th Year Anniversary** of our dental clinic at Kbal Romeas Primary school in Kampot. It was the biggest event we ever had since the project was started. The event was under the chairmanship of HE Sim Vuthea, the Deputer Governor of Kampot and joined by the Directors of Education and Health Provincial Departments, district governor and council, Director of District Office of Education, local authority, BLCP staff and former staff, teachers, parents and children around 500 people.

In his speech HE governor was very impressed with our achievements for the past 10 years and he encouraged all stake holders especially Education and Health departments to closely collaborate with our project.



2- Water Tanks Project

2-1)- Tank Building

In 2017 we built **53** big tanks of 20,000 liters at 53 schools including 18 schools in Kampong Speu, 34 schools in Takeo and 1 school in Kampot. Those tanks provide clean drinking water to **19,859** children every year.



2-2) Bucket and Bottle Delivery

- Delivered **763** white and blue buckets to 51 new schools and 148 old schools.
- Delivered **487** small buckets to 51 new schools.
- Delivered **8,600** bottles to 27 new schools.

2-3) Tank and Gutter Repairs

- Repaired leaking tanks at 40 schools (21 schools were under the contractor's warranty and 19 schools paid by BLCP).
- Replaced gutters at 12 schools.

2-4) School Visits

Every month on average our team and a few CLAs visit between 260 schools. In 2017 all more than 700 schools with BLCP tanks were visited and most of them were visited at least twice.

Among all schools we visited during the time when the schools were running we found that:

- Schools where children used bottles from 0 – 50% : 24%
- Schools where children used bottles from 51 – 70% : 25%
- Schools where children used bottles from 71 – 100% : 55%

Most children at schools near town or market areas usually bring water from home and they drink water from our tanks only when they finish their water and need more. But schools in remote areas especially in Kampong Spue and Takeo, between 7 and 90% of the children drink water from the tanks almost every day.



2-5) Sanitation Facility Building

- Built **16** hand washing facilities at 16 schools. Each school we paid for materials from \$100 to \$200 and the schools contribute the rest.
- Built **4** twin toilets at 4 schools and each school contributes 50%.



3- Education Project

3-1) English Classes (as at end of December, 2017)

- Kampot: **82** classes, **34** teachers and **2156** students
- Kampong Speu: **10** classes, **4** teachers and **211** students
- Takeo: **5** classes, **2** teachers and **140** students.
- Levels:
 - Intermediate : 4 classes : 80 students
 - Pre-Intermediate : 12 classes: 240 students
 - Elementary : 21 classes: 500 students
 - Beginner : 22 classes: 640 students
 - Low Beginner : 16 classes: 419 students
 - Early Beginner : 22 classes: 628 students

Note: the number of students a bit varies from month to month.

3-2) Computer, Non-formal, Preschool Classes and Chinese classes

- Computer Classes: **41** classes, 10 teachers and **274** students.
- Non-Formal Classes: **10** classes, **8** teachers and **250** students.
- Preschool classes: **2** classes, **2** teachers, and 43 kids.
- Chinese classes: **3** classes, **2** teachers and **72** students



3-3) Libraries

- **Library at Kbal Romeas PS:** This library has **1,423** books. **8,205** children came to read and borrowed books in 2017 (approximately 680 children a month).
- **Van Mobile Library:** This mobile library visits around 20 schools a month and around **1,000** children read books from the library. It has **890** books including 366 books bought in 2017.
- **Tuk Tuk Mobile Library in Kampong Trach:** This library is run by a DoE officer. Before it ran only 8 days a month but in the last two months of 2017 we increased it to between 13 and 15 days a month.
- **Tuk Tuk Mobile Library in Boseth, Kampong Speu:** This library started in November, 2017 and the full operation cost was covered by the donation from Australian donor Lean Lee and her friend. It visited 15 schools a month; which enables around 1,000 children to access interesting reading books. It has **240** books and we are providing more books in early 2018.



3-4) Student Graduated

- English classes: **414** students graduated and awarded certificates
 1. Intermediate Level : 41
 2. Pre-Intermediate Level : 213
 3. Elementary Level : 160

- Computer Classes: **149** students graduated and awarded certificates. All of them completed basic course of Ms Word & Excel.



By end of 2017 we found many former students of BLCPC computer and English classes got employment at various places and got scholarship at universities and there are many more whose stories have not been written.

3-5) Annual English Speaking Competition

Every year in April we celebrate the Annual English Speaking Competition. The same as every year in April 2017, we celebrated the Annual English Speaking Competition at Kbal Romeas and we had two debates with four teams and 12 students for presentation.



3-6) School Building

In 2017 we built two schools:

Sre Pring Primary School in Chhouk District, Kampot province where we jointly built a 4-classroom school building with Sipar Organization and Kinal Foundation. The school was completed in September and was officially inaugurated on the 17th of December, 2017 under the chairmanship of Kampot Deputy Governor.



Boeng Touk Primary School in Toek Chhou District, Kampot province where we built a two-classroom building. This school building was donated by Lean Lee and her friends. It was completed in November 2017 and officially inaugurated on the 14th of December, 2017 under the chairmanship of the Director of Kampot Provincial Education Department.



3-7) Jasmine's Club 500

- Provided scholarship to poor students: 8 students
- Provided uniforms to poor children : 359 uniforms
- Provided bicycles to poor children : 41 bikes
- Provided school bags to poor children : 45 bags
- Built a preschool classroom in Banteay Meas district for \$1,568.
- Bought 2 teacher desks for the new school in Boeng Touk for \$120.
- Bought 6 desks, teaching materials and supported half of the salary for the new preschool class in Tropeang Pring village.
