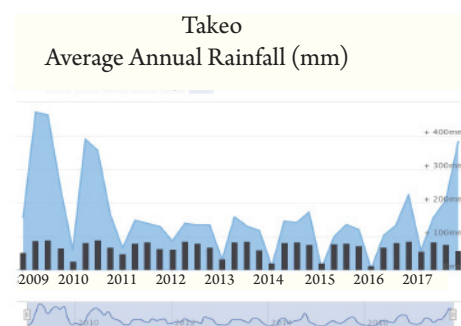
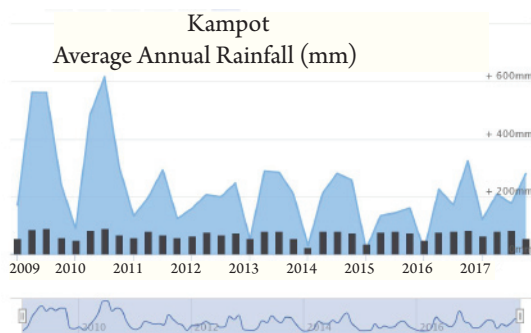


## Across Asia Drought is the Future

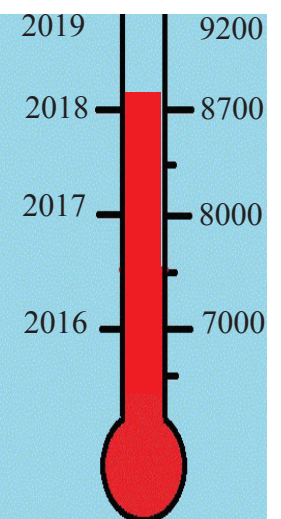
Statistics reveal decreasing rainfall since 2009 in the provinces where we have built water tanks.

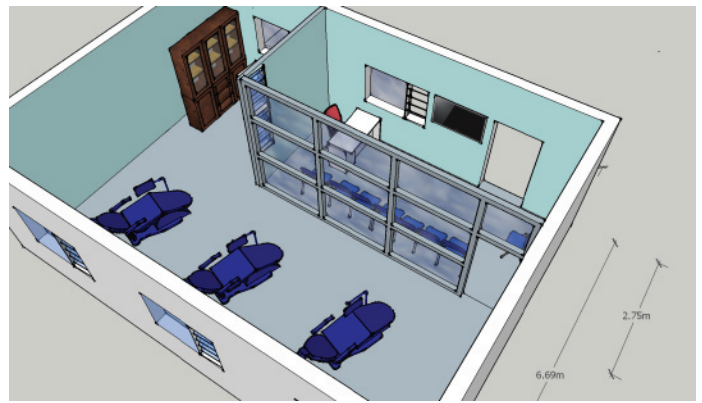
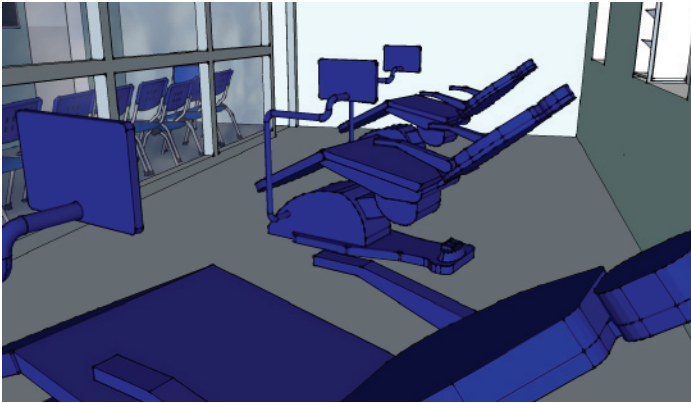

### Yet another English teacher from BLCP for a Cambodian School.

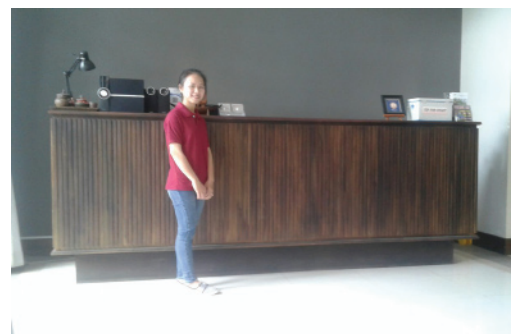


After graduation from our Intermediate level English class, Kimsour was confident of her knowledge in English and selected English as her Major.
